Series Title: The Providence of God.  
The idea of divine providence has all but faded from the language and conscience of both the culture and the church. How we view and understand divine providence has a profound influence on how we view and understand a God who is sovereign over his creation. Not only that, our faith (trust) in what God has done, is doing and shall do is deeply affected by our grasp of the fact that he is providentially causing all things to work for the good of those who love him as well as for the righteous judgment of those who make themselves his enemy.

The series will look at examples of God's providence in scripture and will tackle questions such as:

What is divine providence?

Why is my view of divine providence important?

How can man be "free" and God be sovereign?

If God ordains all things how can we understand evil in light of this truth?
