**Beginning December 2<sup>nd</sup>** Elder Michael Mulconery will begin the first of three short series about dangers the church faces from within and without. From within, we battle the encroaching influences of a postmodern culture which rejects objective Christian truth and reduces it to mere preference. Then we will look at the effects of a diversity which has caused pluralism and inclusivism to not only diminish the Gospel but to make it irrelevant for salvation. From without, we face the astounding impact of false religions, and in particular, Islam. It is estimated by a coalition of American Islamic groups that within the next 27 years (2040) the number of Islamic believers in America alone will rise from a current estimate of 7 million to 50 million. Learning about these issues will help us to respond Christianly to both believers and non-believers as we seek to fulfill the great commission.
