## Children's services are available:

**Nursery**- Birth to 2

**Preschool**- ages 2-4

The elementary classes are working through "Children Desiring God" curriculum for instruction. Children's ministry is optional at the discretion of the parents. Nursery and preschool aged children are checked in at the beginning of service and the elementary groups are dismissed during offering in the order of service. The children's instructors are at the back of church in foyer area where they will meet with dismissed children and then take them downstairs. Children need to be picked up following the service.

- **SGF Members** - The elders have assigned "mini-flocks" that compromise all members of the church divided to each elder respectively.
