## Children's services available:

- Nursery - Birth to 2 years of age (located just off the foyer)
- Preschool - ages 2-4
- Elementary classes - grades K-2 (ages 5-8),

Classrooms are through the foyer and downstairs.

Children's ministry is optional at discretion of parents.
