## Children's services available:

- Nursery - Birth to 2 years of age (located just off the foyer)
- Preschool - ages 2-4
- Elementary classes - grades K-2 (ages 5-8),  
- grades 3-5 (ages 9-11)

Classrooms are through the foyer and downstairs.

Children's ministry is optional at discretion of parents. Nursery and preschool children may be checked in prior to worship service and elementary groups are dismissed during offering in the order of service (except first Sunday each month when all elementary age children remain in service). Children's instructors are at the back of church in foyer area where they will meet with dismissed children and then take them downstairs. Children need to be picked up promptly following service.

Children's activity packs and sermon worksheets are available in the foyer for those who prefer to remain during worship and sermon.
