All food and beverages, other than water, are limited to the non carpeted areas outside the sanctuary area. The bistro area in the back is available should anyone need a snack during services.

We're glad you could be with us today! Please fill out a visitor card, in the foyer, so we can get to know you.

Children's services available: Suspended during pandemic and until further notice.

- **Nursery** - Open for diaper changes and quiet place.
- **Toddler Program** - Proficient Walkers to age 2. Located downstairs in the room next to the Preschool program.
- **Preschool** - potty trained ages 3-4, downstairs in the Pre-K room
- **Elementary classes**
 - **grades K-2 (ages 5-8)**, downstairs classroom, next to kitchen
 - **grades 3-5 (ages 9-11)**, Located upstairs in classroom.

A teacher will be in back of the sanctuary to escort children to their room, and also will bring the children back to be picked up after close of service.

Children's ministry is optional at discretion of parents. Toddler and preschool children may be checked in prior to worship service and elementary groups are dismissed during offering in the order of service (except first Sunday each month when school age children remain in service). Children need to be picked up promptly following service.
